How to Saturate and Clean with Premira® Mop Pads:



- 1. Remove the paper band around the bundle of 20 Premira® mop pads (PRMM0001)
- 2. Place the mops in the bucket, printed side up.



- 1. Fill 3 quart bottles with the appropriate chemical (neutral floor cleaner).
- 2. Pour both quart bottles evenly over the entire bundle to evenly saturate the mop pads.
- 3. Keep an extra quart bottle of chemical on your cart and add chemical as needed.



- 1. Adjust the height of your mop handle.
- 2. Open cam-lock, extend to desired height, close cam-lock.
- 3. The ideal handle height is just below chin level.



- 1. Attach the handle to the blue mop frame by lining up the two prongs on the frame with the Z-clip on the handle.
- 2. Press the handle down firmly onto the frame until you hear a "click".



- 1. Lay the saturated mop pad out on the floor with the printed side up.
- 2. Line the frame up flush on one short mop edge, leaving a 1-inch lip on the other side of the frame.
- 3. Start mopping from the back of the room to the front and use "S-motion" so the same edge is always leading.



- 1. To remove the used mop, simply pull soiled pad up from bottom of frame to fold in half.
- 2. Once it's folded in half, pull it down to middle of the frame and remove.
- 3. This technique makes sure that all contaminants are contained inside the used mop and aren't spread back into the room.
